

Japan Open 2026 Accommodation Guidelines

The Japan Open 2026 will provide the following complimentary / general accommodation options for participants.

Complimentary Accommodation

Participants who meet any of the following criteria will be offered free venue accommodation.

Accommodation Details

- Single room
- 5 nights (Check-in: 20 November / Check-out: 25 November)
- Breakfast buffet included

Eligibility

Participants who meet **any** of the following:

- GM with FIDE rating **2450 or higher**: up to **4 players**
- GM / IM / WGM with FIDE rating **2350 or higher**: up to **6 players**

The rooms will be allocated **in descending order of FIDE rating based on 1st September** among eligible applicants.

If there are any remaining slots, they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis to applicants who meet the eligibility criteria.

*Ratings will be verified based on the FIDE rating list published on 1st September.

*If a player wishes to extend their stay beyond 25 November, conditions for additional nights will be discussed separately.

Deposit

A deposit of **50,000 yen** will be collected from complimentary accommodation users.

The deposit will be refunded promptly after confirming the following:

- The player participates in **all rounds** with **no absences or withdrawals**
- No serious issues occur involving the venue accommodation or tournament operations

General Accommodation

General participants and accompanying persons may book venue accommodation under the following conditions.

Accommodation Details

- Up to **40 rooms**
- Single room
- **12,000 yen per night / per person (tax included)**
- Available from check-in on **20 November** to check-out on **26 November**
- Breakfast buffet: **1,500 yen per person (tax included)**, must be booked **together with the accommodation** *Breakfast cannot be added at check-in.*

Rooms are limited and will be allocated **on a first-come, first-served basis**.

How to Apply

Participants must complete tournament entry before applying for accommodation.

Complimentary Accommodation

Only players who meet the eligibility criteria may apply. If not all rooms are taken after the deadline, an additional call for applicants may be made.

*Offers will close once all places are filled.

Cancellation Policy

If you wish to cancel or modify your accommodation reservation, contact the tournament office promptly.

Accommodation cancellation fees may be set as follows:

Cancellation Date	Fee
By 21 st October	0%
From 22 nd October	100%

If a complimentary accommodation user cancels their tournament participation or venue accommodation, refund of the deposit will be determined individually based on cancellation timing, venue accommodation costs incurred, and operational impact.

Venue Accommodation Information

Cross-Wave Makuhari (3-minute walk from JR Keiyo Line “Kaihin-Makuhari” Station, North Exit) *Same location as the tournament venue* [Webページ](#)

- Single room: 16 m²
- All rooms non-smoking



Additional Notes

- Accommodation is confirmed only after receiving a confirmation message from the tournament office. Even within the application period, rooms may not be available due to full occupancy or operational constraints.
- Payment methods and deadlines for accommodation and breakfast fees will be communicated separately. Failure to pay by the specified deadline may result in cancellation of the reservation.
- Requests to change dates, guest information, or breakfast options must be made promptly. Changes depend on room availability and venue accommodation coordination.
- If your expected check-in time is later than **11:00 PM (23:00)**, you must notify the contact designated by the Tournament Organizing Committee in advance.
- Guests are required to read the Guest Information and House Rules published on the official website of the accommodation facility before their stay.

- Guests shall comply with the accommodation facility's **Guest Information, House Rules**, in-house guidance, and any instructions issued by the organizer during their stay. For accommodation conditions, accommodation fees, breakfast reservations, bed-sharing policy, cancellation policy, and other matters relating to accommodation reservations, please refer to these Accommodation Terms and Conditions.
- Children eligible to share a bed with a parent or guardian must be **6 years of age or younger** as of the check-in date. Only **one child per bed** may share a bed. Children aged **7 years or older** as of the check-in date are not eligible for bed-sharing and will be charged the regular accommodation rate if staying at the hotel.
- Accommodation by minors shall be subject to the policies of the accommodation facility. In accordance with the facility's regulations, guests under **18 years of age**

may be required to submit a parental consent form bearing the handwritten signature of a parent or legal guardian. If such submission is required, the organizer will provide instructions regarding the submission procedure and deadline separately.

- Guests wishing to have breakfast must reserve it at the time of submitting their accommodation application. Breakfast reservations cannot be added at check-in. Breakfast for children aged **6 years or younger** who are sharing a bed with a parent or guardian is not complimentary; the regular breakfast fee will apply if breakfast is requested.
- Guests shall be solely responsible for any consequences arising from their failure to comply with the accommodation facility's rules, guidance, or instructions issued by the organizer regarding the use of the accommodation facility.
- As a general rule, the organizer will not become involved in personal disputes arising between guests or between a guest and a third party during the accommodation period. However, this shall not apply if the Organizer determines that the matter has a significant impact on the operation of the tournament, the safety of other participants, the use of the accommodation facility, or the reputation of the tournament.
- In such cases, the organizer may prohibit the participant concerned from taking part in any subsequent rounds of the tournament. In such circumstances, no refunds of the entry fee, accommodation fee, or any other fees already paid will be made, regardless of the reason.
- If a guest causes damage to the accommodation facility, its equipment, fixtures, or other property, the guest shall be fully responsible for all repair costs, cleaning fees, replacement costs, and any other charges imposed by the accommodation facility.
- If there is a discrepancy between English and Japanese, the Japanese version prevails.
